PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Life Pacific University Online Dual Enrollment program allows qualified high school students to earn college credit and credit towards their high school diploma by taking fully online courses from LPU's undergraduate program. The courses are taught by experienced professors and utilize an 8-week format. With accreditation from WSCUC and ABHE, the program guarantees high-quality education. Students can interact with professors and join college-level students, providing a head start in college. With LPU's Dual Enrollment Program, students can jumpstart their college education today!

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Dual Enrollment courses offered by Life Pacific University, students must be sophomores, juniors or seniors in high school. Additionally, they must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 and provide a recommendation from a high school counselor or teacher. Students can enroll in one course the first time to ensure they are able to meet university-level demands. If a student successfully passes the course, LPU will allow the student to register in up to two courses (6 credits) at a time (8 weeks) to ensure academic success.
