FORMAT & SCHEDULE

The online bachelor's program is a 4-year degree taught 100% online. Students can begin in either the fall or spring semester. Each semester is divided into two 8-week sessions with two classes per session and one 16-week course that stretches across the entire semester. In addition to weekly reading and assignments, students will participate in discussion boards with professors and peers. Students will be enrolled in a full-time course load and should expect to spend an average of 12-15 hours per course each week.
